

**If you see this sign in your neighborhood you may want to FIND OUT MORE**

This is part of a Mesh Network being deployed in Palm Beach County that is already inundated with overpowered wireless facilities that have NO CURRENT HUMAN EXPOSURE GUIDELINES.

Questions on privacy and CYBER SECURITY remain unanswered.



- Having a wireless facility in the Right-of-Way by your home can debase your property value by 20% (15% - 30%).
- The service is described as high-speed broadband internet, but what speed does that actually mean? Does this system close the Digital Divide or widen it?
- The 2019 Federal Communication Commission Human Exposure Guidelines for Radio-Frequency/Microwave Radiation, including the technologies of this mesh network, were thrown out of court (remanded back to them) in August 2021. The current federal wireless safety guidelines, that exempt Telecom from liability, revert to the previous antiquated ones that are based on 11 monkeys and 12 rats exposed for less than one hour in the 1980s. Telecom is protected. YOU are not. The FCC is now claiming confusion over the most recent studies they commissioned verifying evidence of DNA damage and showing more evidence of harm including brain damage and cancer. They have announced they will do no more studies and have not responded to the court's remand.
- This Mesh Network is connected to the Cloud and can involve the use of Wireless Body Area Networks (WBANs) that incorporate the human body as nodes on their networks. The Human Collection (HBC) band of WBAN is galvanic, duplexed and is sinked to biosensors on and/or in the body. Biosensor data transmission to and from the body may be powered by harvesting energy from the body. You may not be aware of the presence of these sinks and biosensors that may be in your body and the use of them does not require your consent. Major cyber security, privacy and health issues exist.
- The built out mesh network will emit cell tower levels of radiation, estimated at 100 to 900 KW. The environmental impacts have not been studied.
